Established in 1996, the Colorado Association for School-Based Health Care is a nonprofit membership organization working to bring health care to children and adolescents where they spend a great deal of their time—in school. CASBHC is an affiliate of the National Assembly on School-Based Health Care and promotes the development of school-based health centers throughout the state. CASBHC provides:

Advocacy

CASBHC strives to keep policymakers informed about the benefits of the school-based health center model while working to increase state and federal funding for the delivery of primary and preventive health care to school-aged children.

Training and Technical Assistance

CASBHC actively engages communities that want to open a school-based health center. CASBHC helps navigate through the process including building key community-based partnerships, securing funding, and engaging parents and students. If a school-based health center requires personal, one-on-one assistance, the staff at CASBHC is available to make site visits and provide tailored assistance.

Annual Conference

Each year CASBHC brings together leadership from school-based health centers throughout Colorado for an annual conference. The conference allows participants to network, jointly resolve issues of mutual interest, replicate successes, and share lessons learned.

Rural Health Consortium

CASBHC holds gatherings for school-based health centers in rural areas to relieve isolation and exchange solutions to challenges unique to a rural setting.

Quality Improvement

CASBHC collects, analyzes, and reports accurate information regarding the size and scope of school-based health care in Colorado. CASBHC also seeks funding to test, refine, and replicate model programs in school-based health centers.

Types of Membership
